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Press Release: UCRRA Zero Waste Seminar Project

November 19th 2020

The Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency (UCRRA) has been selected as one of eleven recipients of the 2020-2021 Community Grants Program, a project of the New York State Pollution Prevention Institute (NYSP2I). UCRRA will launch a county-wide community engagement campaign, the UCRRA Zero Waste Seminar Project, to raise awareness of the environmental impacts of single use plastics, and how waste reduction

and reuse can be practical strategies for pollution prevention.

The project will feature a series of public workshops, webinars, and panel-style presentations, a social media/radio/news ad campaign and will utilize a variety of Partnerships. Project partners will collaborate by providing guest speakers, or venue spaces for the workshops, or by helping to spread awareness of the campaign.

The project supporters include: Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster County, Riverkeeper, Climate Smart Gardiner, Office of Campus Sustainability at SUNY New Paltz, Woodstock Land Conservancy, Woodstock Bring Your Own Store, and Repair Café Hudson Valley, New Paltz Climate Action Coalition, Town of Saugerties Chamber of Commerce, League of Women Voters, Saugerties Public Library, Kingston Public Library, and the Stone Ridge Public Library.

The project will help citizens learn practical skills to lead a ‘zero waste lifestyle’ that maximizes the reduction of disposable plastics. The project will educate the public about: ocean plastic pollution, pollution from waste and from plastic, rethinking waste through zero waste practices, and other conservation techniques. The project is planned to launch during July 2021 to align with messaging around Plastic Free July, which is an initiative of the Plastic Free Foundation.

Locally, the project addresses a relevant community need for county-wide education about reducing the waste stream. In recent months the UCRRA Board of Directors approved its 10 year solid waste management plan that identified waste reduction and community engagement goals. The County of Ulster has also shown leadership in acting on a growing community concern about the effects of plastic waste. In November 2019 the County of Ulster adopted Resolution #451 establishing a policy that Ulster County shall be a zero waste community. The Ulster County Bring Your Own Bag Act, the Food Service Waste Reduction Act, and the Ulster County Skip the Straw Act also address the urgent need to reduce plastic waste in our communities.

“We feel that this is a critical time and a unique opportunity to refine outreach approaches about single use disposable plastics, and that the project complements the County’s efforts to educate the public about plastic pollution and waste reduction.” – Angelina Peone, Recycling Coordinator at UCRRA

The ZWSP also addresses a relevant need for UCRRA, indirectly adding benefits of an improved recycling system with less contamination. While the Zero Waste Seminar Project does not focus on recycling education, it emphasizes source reduction as a strategy to prevent the environmental pollution associated with discarding and using plastics, thereby inherently adding benefits to the greater County recycling system. More information about the project will become available on the Agency’s website in the coming months.

The UCRRA ZERO WASTE SEMINAR PROJECT is a community engagement project by the Ulster County

Resource Recovery Agency, celebrating Plastic Free July and the many ways we can prevent pollution from our waste. Access to Ancestry Library Edition has been temporarily expanded to library cardholders working remotely, courtesy of ProQuest and its partner Ancestry. Remote access will be available until **December 31st 2020** and will be re-evaluated monthly as needed.



Dear **ProQuest** Customer:

We are writing today to inform you about a usage issue with Ancestry Library Edition and Heritage Quest Online. Last June, Ancestry was making some upgrades to the image viewer that would improve the security of the content, make content more accessible, reduce down time and improve response time when returning search results. During this upgrade, an error occurred with how page views were being counted with this image viewer. Unfortunately, this issue persisted until January 19, 2021, and the usage data (page views) has been permanently lost. After analysis, Ancestry estimates that actual usage was roughly double what the reported statistics indicate during this period (June 2020 – January 19, 2021). Ancestry has reviewed the situation and will put monitoring in place so that issues can be addressed in a more timely fashion.

Part 2: Overdrive (Formerly RBDigital)

AcornTV notified Overdrive of their decision to discontinue service. Overdrive is hopeful that they will be able to renegotiate the contract in the future. However, Overdrive cannot speak to what or when this will happen.

The following are the streaming services that they do offer:

- **ArtistWorks:** World-class instruction for the most popular string and band instruments through self-paced video lessons from professional musicians. *(Flat Fee Unknown)*
- **Craftsy:** An online resource for all creative makers from basic instruction to advanced techniques for fabric and yarn crafts, baking, drawing, and much more. *(Flat Fee Unknown)*
- **The Great Courses:** Engaging and understandable lectures by esteemed professors, professionals, and experts in topics ranging from history, better living, science, language learning, and much more. *(Per Circ Usage of \$2.99)*
- **IndieFlix:** A streaming movie service that offers access to pop culture favorites, box office hits, award-winning feature films, documentaries, and shorts. *(Per Circ Usage of \$2.99)*
- **LawDepot:** An extensive library of documents and legal resources that serves a wide range of legal needs. *(Flat Fee Unknown)*
- **Method Test Prep:** Lessons and resources that help students prepare for the SAT and ACT. *(Per Circ Usage of \$2.99)*
- **Learn it Live:** On-demand and live courses centered on wellness. *(Per Circ Usage of \$2.99)*
- **Qello:** The world's largest collection of full-length concerts and music documentaries streamed on-demand to just about any device. *(Per Circ Usage of \$2.99)*
- **Universal Class:** Lifelong learning courses in over 30 subject areas, many of which offer continuing education units (CEUs). **(Central Library Funds)**

Platform Fee: Overdrive is no longer requiring an \$1800 platform fee. If the UCLA decides to sign up for a per circ database, Overdrive requires an \$1800 deposit which will be spent down during the year.

Patron Access: These databases will be available through the Libby App. We will not be able to restrict usage to two tokens per person per month.

Platform: Overdrive could migrate services across individual Advantage accounts or they can create a separate platform for the Ulster County Library Association.

We have \$9000 budgeted for RBDigital. Last year, Great Courses, IndieFlix and Qello cost \$1527.89. We are on track this year to spend about the same amount (\$263.12*6).

Method Test Prep: This database is covered by Tutor.com.

Learn It Live: We found that some of the content redirected patrons to paid content.

Universal Class: Available with MHLS system.

Recommendation:

Despite the fact that Overdrive is losing our biggest performer – AcornTV – the committee still recommends that we create a platform for Ulster Libraries with at least a subscription to Great Courses. This will likely be a better option for the RCLS libraries to access the collection. It will allow for easier billing. (We are not even sure how we would divide out the monies across the Advantage accounts.). It will also ensure that we are billed for patrons with Ulster County Library Cards as opposed to anyone in the library system. The UCLA will also be more likely to be able attribute the resources to the Ulster County Legislature.

Depending on how much extra usage we want to gamble on with the new four circulation per user threshold, we can add on IndieFlix and Qello. (We are on track to spend about \$35,300 on Kanopy with our current spending rate. We have a cap of \$34,500)

In addition the committee recommends that the UCLA authorizes the committee to review ArtistWorks, LawDepot, and Craftsy. The contract is due by the end of the month. If the committee is satisfied with the content and pricing, we ask for authorization to purchase them.
