Our contract for Tutor.com should have ended this past summer, however it has been extended for free through the end of the year or until all our sessions are used up. Tutor.com will also be offering free staff webinars. The consensus was that Thursdays and Fridays at 9am are the best times to offer this training, but being able to archive the sessions is best. Jim Cosgrove will be contacting the vendor to see if use statistics by library are available. Bookmarks are available on the staff portion of the UCLA webpage.

Amy Raff was unable to make the meeting, but she will be emailing everyone the database use statistics.

Kelly Tomaseski suggested advertising the Infoportal on some of the local television stations.

Sukrit reported on the Employee Assistance Program. Mary Dyer has emailed everyone the one page questionnaire that must be completed by all participating libraries. Sukrit will be emailing participating directors a welcome letter that can be given to staff. The cost of the program is based on how many full time equivalent employees each library has. Benefits may start as early as March 1st, but it depends on everyone submitting their questionnaire.

An Ad Hoc Committee has been created to deal with the creation of county wide medical collection. Each library is encouraged to weed their medical books as directed by MHLS. Kara Lustiber, Sukrit Goswami, Kelly Tomaseski, and Jim Cosgrove will meet with Deb from PPLD to discuss creating a core collection each library should have, as well as specialty topics. We may be able to use county funding to cover some of the cost of the core collections. In addition, libraries would choose a specialty that they would be responsible for keeping up to date. For example, the Esopus Library may choose tick-borne diseases. Smaller libraries would not be required to participate, but may want to work together to cover one specialty. It is UCLA's hope that as a county we can provide our patrons with the most up to date medical information, while keeping our individual costs low.

Kara contacted the person in charge of the Ulster County Fair. UCLA will have a table to advertise and will be given a certain number of free tickets for those manning the table. The fair runs July 30th through August 4th. Katie Scott-Childress offered to help with this project.

Margie reported that we need volunteers to attend the Ulster County Government Programs Committee meetings that meet the second Wednesday of each month at 5pm at Ulster County Community College. We need new faces to share their warm and fuzzy library stories. If you plan to speak, you must be added to the agenda ahead of time.

Public Relations: (Faith Johnson, James Cosgrove, Jody Ford, John Giralico, Heather Olson) The committee has been communicating via email.

Website: (Kara Lustiber, James Cosgrove, Sukrit Goswami) Kara is installing antivirus software to the UCLA webpage to avoid being hacked (as has happened to several sites hosted by Joomla and Wordpress). Kara has added a list of the most downloaded ebooks & audiobooks to the UCLA webpage. Brainpop is still able to be authenticated via barcode. Kelly has revived the Facebook page and has made several individuals managers of the site. Please feel free to add events/news to the page.
