Minutes: Margie Menard made a motion to approve the June meeting minutes, 2nd. Approved.

Dues Increase (report attached): The UCLA board recommends an increase to the UCLA dues for the 2020 fiscal year. The dues have not been increased in several years. An increase will enable the organization the option to provide more services to the county libraries. If agreed upon, the 2020 bills will be sent out in September 2019.

Selection Committee

<u>Ancestry Renewal</u> – Katie Scott-Childress moved that the Ancestry database be renewed for \$13,000. This will include Ancestry in-library use, HeritageQuest remote access, and Fold3 remote access. 2nd. Approved.

Kanopy – NY Public Library ended their subscription to Kanopy beginning in July 2019. The committee is concerned that this may increase the amount of usage locally. Katie Scott-Childress contacted the company and received the following information:

- most users are only streaming one or two items which means that lowering the cap to four would not have much of an effect on total usage
- content can be curated so Great Courses was blocked (available on RB Digital)
- a detailed report showing how much usage can be attributed to each library has been requested
- libraries may be asked to provide monies towards the support of this platform
- Kanopy is going to provide a new contract proposal in which monies not spent will be rolled over to the next year but any usage over will be covered by the contract.
