UCLA MEETING MINUTES July 20, 2021

SPEAKER:

Su Marcy from the United Way of Ulster County presented. Discussion included information on varied programs, such as VITA tax assistance programs, 211 24/7 help line service, and the ways in which UW can assist in connecting people to needed services. Christina Jennerich made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 15, 2021 meeting. Second by Mary Collins. All in favor. Approved.

Gillian Thorpe Murphy made a motion to accept the Treasurers report. Second by Jessica Kerr. All in favor. Approved.

Margie Menard made a motion to nominate Kenneth Goldberg to a second five-year term (2022-2026) on the MHLS Board of Directors. Second by Gillian Thorpe Murphy. No other nominations are brought forth. All in favor. Approved. Thanks are expressed to Ken.

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

Discussion of the renewal of Ancestry.com. It is suggested that Ancestry should not be renewed due to ongoing issues with the vendor that includes billing and usage data problems. The vendor has expressed that the product will be revamped in 2022, without offering any additional information. Margie Menard made a motion to cancel Ancestry.com. Second by Jessica Kerr. 1 nay, 1 abstain. Approved.

Discussion of adding Indieflix to the Ulster County Overdrive platform. It is mentioned that patrons have expressed interest in the resource, and that Indieflix will complement the existing streaming resources already available. Gillian Thorpe Murphy made a motion to add the Indieflix option to Overdrive. Second by Nicole Lane. All in favor. Approved.

Member libraries were asked to review BrainHQ and send any input to selection committee members (Margie Menard, Kara Lustiber, Julie Dempsey, Kristen Campbell, Christina Jennerich, Katie Scott-Childress). It will be considered as a resource to be added in the future.

SUBJECT: **ELECTION OF MHLS TRUSTEE FROM ULSTER COUNTY**

The election of MHLS trustees will be an item of business at *the Mid-Hudson Library System's Annual*

Membership Meeting, Friday, October 22, 2021. MHLS is governed by a fifteen-member board, three trustees from each of the five counties served. A Term of Office is defined in the MHLS Bylaws, Article IV. Section 4, as follows:

Terms shall be staggered so that three shall expire on the 31st day of December each year. A term of office of a trustee shall be five years. A trustee may not serve more than two consecutive full five-year terms, except where previously appointed or elected to fill an unexpired term. Following such service a trustee may again be appointed or elected after an interim of at least one-year.

One of the three Ulster County seats on the MHLS Board needs to be elected for a new five-year term (2022-2026). This seat is currently held by Kenneth Goldberg who is eligible to serve for another five-year term.

MHLS NOMINATION PROCESS

The county library association of each county for which a trustee is to be elected shall meet for the purpose of selecting a candidate from their county to nominate. The chair of the county library association shall submit to the MHLS Executive Director the name of the county library association's nominee no later than two months prior to the Annual Membership Meeting. In the event a county does not put forth a candidate, the MHLS Executive Director, in consultation with the MHLS Board President, shall seek a nominee from that county where a vacancy needs to be filled.

MHLS member libraries are chartered to provide service to every resident in its service area – residents who comprise a broad range of backgrounds, perspectives and expectations. Similarly, the MHLS Board should be comprised of members who, in the aggregate, can touch upon many of these backgrounds to better understand the diverse needs of each member library. Board diversity can take many forms, as explained in the enclosed, "Achieving Diversity within the MHLS Board of Trustees," document prepared by the MHLS Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Working Group. We ask for your help in creating a diverse MHLS Board that helps to reflect the rich diversity of the residents of the Hudson Valley.

If you wish to nominate an Ulster County representative to the MHLS Board of Trustees, please provide their name and contact information to Margie Menard, Director of the Kingston Library & Chair of the Ulster County Library Association. Nominations are due to Ms. Menard prior to July 1, 2021. You may contact Ms. Menard at 845-339-4260 ext. 14 or mmenard@kingstonlibrary.org

Rebekkah Smith-Aldrich has informed me that I am coming to the end of my first term of service on the MHLS Board of Directors. It's hard to believe the time has passed so quickly. As Rebekkah will soon let you know, I am very eager to continue my MHLS service with a second term on the Board and I hope that UCLA will see its way to nominating me for that second term. The committee met on June 30th.

<p>Notes about Ancestry:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• With help from Laurie Shedrick from MHLS, ProQuest believes that they can offer each MHLS library a unique embedded URL which will yield accurate statistics for the remote Ancestry.com.• Laurie discovered that the system actually recorded 29,000 remote Ancestry circs for Jan-June 2021• ProQuest will be working on improving technical remote access connectivity. They hope to have their new system available in early 2022.• Remote access for Ancestry has been extended to the end of the year. (Right now, the entire system can access through MHLS.) ProQuest is unable to commit to Ancestry authorizing remote access past that time although they are hopeful that this will happen.• \$13,389 to renew on 7/31/21. (We paid the same amount last year.)• ProQuest will not renew Ancestry, HeritageQuest, and FOLD3 for 6 months <p>The committee currently does not recommend renewing Ancestry because of the uncertainty of remote access as well as the ongoing issues with gathering statistics.</p>
IndieFlix
<p>UCLA purchased \$1800 worth of content in May. \$2.99 per 7 day access for each database. Unlimited number of weeks and database selections. We have used \$56.81 for our two months of Great Courses.</p> <p>Given the small amount of usage, the committee recommends that we add IndieFlix.</p>
Overdrive eMags (formerly Zinio)
<p>The Central Library has returned \$3000 to the UCLA for eMags.</p>
Mango
<p>The Central Library will not be billing the association \$2203.41 for the MHLS Mango subscription. The association will still pay \$1231 for the RCLS libraries.</p> <p>Please note: Jerry from RCLS had this comment about Mango: We used to license Mango systemwide before Rosetta Stone became available via EBSCO--Rosetta Stone's language lessons may be better, but the login and authentication is very confusing to users, especially app users. So I'd hesitate to recommend RS over Mango.</p>

Dear **ProQuest** Customer:

We are writing today to inform you about a usage issue with Ancestry Library Edition and Heritage Quest Online. Last June, Ancestry was making some upgrades to the image viewer that would improve the security of the content, make content more accessible, reduce down time and improve response time when returning search results. During this upgrade, an error occurred with how page views were being counted with this image viewer. Unfortunately, this issue persisted until January 19, 2021, and the usage data (page views) has been permanently lost. After analysis, Ancestry estimates that actual usage was roughly double what the reported statistics indicate during this period (June 2020 – January 19, 2021). Ancestry has reviewed the situation and will put monitoring in place so that issues can be addressed in a more timely fashion.

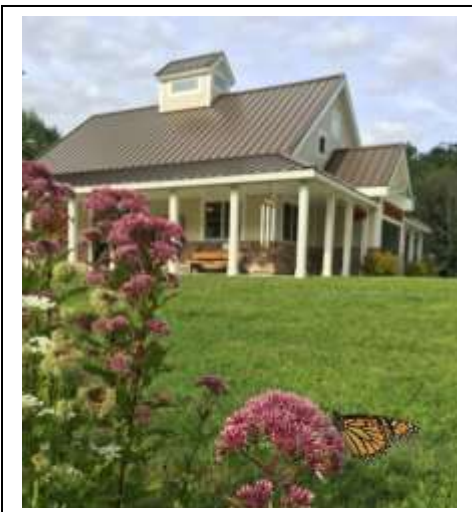
