The meeting of the Ulster County Library Association was called to order by Katie Scott-Childress at 10:02 am virtually, via Zoom.

A representative from Crafts & Hobby database demonstrated features of the product. Crafts & Hobby is an on-demand video tutorial catalog in the crafts and hobbies space. A subscription to the database is being considered, to be purchased with remaining funds in the 2023 Ulster County Legislature funding year.

Minutes:

Julie Kelsall-Dempsey made a motion to approve the July 11, 2023 minutes. Darren Lanspery seconded. All-in favor. Approved.

Selection Committee Report:

Kara Lustiber made a motion to use \$1460 from the Love Your Library Special Funds to purchase museum passes. Julie Kelsall-Dempsey seconded. All in favor. Approved.

Discussion surrounding the quality of content and ease of use of Crafts & Hobby. Kara Lustiber made a motion to use \$2500 from remaining 2023 legislative funds to purchase Crafts & Hobby database. Gillian Murphy seconded. All in favor. Approved.

Discussion regarding the funding request proposal for the upcoming years Ulster County legislative session. Kara Lustiber made a motion to accept the budget of the funding proposal. Julie Kelsall-Dempsey seconded. Katie Scott Childress will contact select legislators individually to gauge interest in the Dolly Parton Imagination Library program and inquire as to other potential funding possibilities. It

will be not be proposed to the legislature as a UCLA funding request at this time. Discussion regarding Hoopla as a possible UCLA purchase. Logistics for a county-wide purchase would need to be considered. All in favor. Approved.

Discussion regarding the remaining funds in the 2023 budget year (in part due to Transparent Language now being funded through MHLS). Kara Lustiber will explore options for pre-paying museum passes and /or the Tixkeeper subscription to utilize the funds. Kara Lustiber made a motion to allow the selection committee discretion over using the remaining funds to purchase museum passes/Tixkeeper and Overdrive items. Gisi Vella seconded. All in favor. Approved.

MHLS Board Nominations:

Ivy Gocker made a motion to nominate Stuart Auchincloss to the Mid-Hudson Library System Board of Trustees. Darren Lanspery seconded. All in favor. Approved.

Publicity & Digital Resource Manager Ad-hoc Committee:

Discussion regarding the hiring of a contractor to manage digital resources and publicity. Jen Russell and Tracy Priest volunteered to write the job description. Tasks include managing the museum pass program and creating social media posts to promote the UCLA digital resources.

UCLA Annual Dinner:

Gillian Murphy will send out invitations to the annual dinner to be held at Dixon Roadside, Woodstock. Ivy Gocker will offer a pre-dinner tour of the new Woodstock Library building, pre-renovation. A speaker for the event is tbd.

RSAC Report:

Darren Lanspery reported that the RSAC is exploring standards and procedures for handling seasonal patron cardholders. Laurie Shedrick is assisting with clarifying relevant wording.

Part 1 – Love Your Library


We are being awarded \$1460 from the state to support summer reading programs.

Part 2 – Crafts & Hobby

Released a few months ago to library subscribers, TN Marketing will be offering their individual subscription content to libraries. Their subscription model is an annual one (not pay as you go). Patrons are given unlimited access to their content. They own Craftsy as well as 16 other platforms with content that will be included. Everything is filmed in-house. The tutorials include PDFs with the patterns and any related information.

The cost of the database for the county would be \$2500.

Play Credit Breakdown: Libraries set the number of play credits per month. Once a patron plays a film, they have unlimited watches for 48 to 72 hours. The cost is \$2.00 - \$4.00 per play credit for all films on Kanopy other than Kanopy Kids and the Great Courses. Note: When a patron uses a play credit, this allows them 72 hours of access to the film, during which they have unlimited access. This means they can play the same film several times per play credit, meaning that the total number of "plays" on your platform will be higher than the total number of "play credits" used.

Then you have KKids (Kanopy Kids) and KSeries (The Great Courses) which are defined as follows:

Unlimited Access Model for Kanopy Kids/Great Course

- Kanopy Kids- Kanopy Kids provides patrons with 30 days of unlimited plays for any video in Kanopy Kids for \$5. This means that once a patron plays 5 seconds or more of a video, the patron will have unlimited plays for any other video(s) in the Kanopy Kids section for the next 30 days. The \$5 fee will trigger on the date of the first play and be invoiced at the end of the calendar month. Monthly invoices will include Kanopy Kids charges as a separate line item. Kanopy Kids does not use a patron credit.
- The Great Courses- With The Great Courses on Kanopy, your library patrons have 30 rolling days to watch an entire series from The Great Courses once they press play on any title in that series without incurring additional charges to your library. Your library will be invoiced \$5 for every Great Courses series that a patron presses play on. Access to that course remains open for 30 days. Each additional series played from The Great Courses will incur an additional \$5 charge to your library.

The \$5 fee will trigger on the date of the first play and will be invoiced at the end of the calendar month. These charges are listed as "KSeries" on your invoice.
